When you create an online account, you will also have access to future additions such as an online directory and text giving. Online Giving

1. Click on the give button to enter AccessACS, our online giving portal.
2. Create an account
3. Enter the amount you are giving, choose an account (Missions, General, Memorials, etc.) from the drop down menu, add an additional memo if needed to designate memorial names etc.
4. Click the add more link on the right if you want to give to more than one fund. You may give to as many different funds as you'd like.
5. Set up the frequency of your giving
6. Choose the method of giving: credit card, savings account, checking account. Bank accounts will be withdrawn automatically. Click on the box at the bottom to save your billing information for the future.
7. Finally, proofread all your information, then click the give button at bottom of the page.
